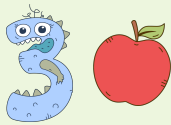
Read together. Use the pictures to help solve each story.

Grade 1

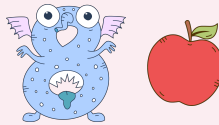
- 1 There are 3 apples in a basket. Sam adds 8 more apples.

How many apples are there now?

$$\begin{array}{c} 3 + 8 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$

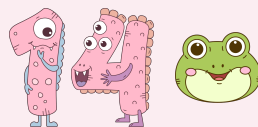
- 2 There are 17 frogs by a pond. Then 14 frogs jump away.

How many frogs are left?

$$\begin{array}{c} 17 - 14 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$

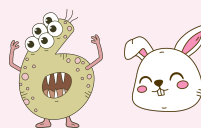
- 3 There are 12 rabbits in a garden. Then 6 more rabbits hop in.

How many rabbits are there now?

START WITH



ADD



$$\begin{array}{c} 12 + 6 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$
