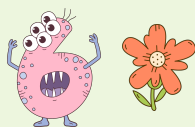

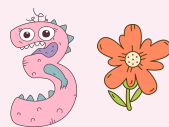

START WITH



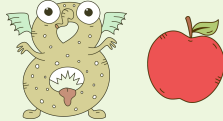
TAKE AWAY



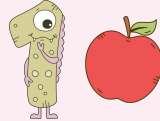
$$\begin{array}{c} 6 - 3 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$
