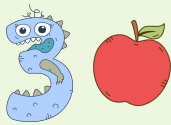
Read together. Use the pictures to help solve each story.

Grade 1

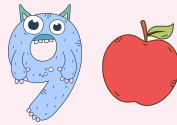
- 1 There are 3 apples in a basket. Sam adds 9 more apples.

ADD

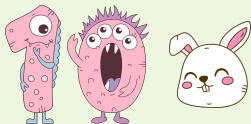


$$\begin{array}{c} 3 + 9 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$

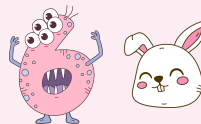
- 2 There are 10 rabbits in a garden. Then 6 rabbits hop away.

$$\begin{array}{c} 10 - 6 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$

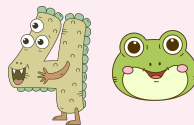
- 3 There are 12 frogs by a pond. Then 4 more frogs jump over.

How many frogs are there now?

START WITH



ADD



$$\begin{array}{c} 12 + 4 \\ = \end{array} \boxed{}$$
