



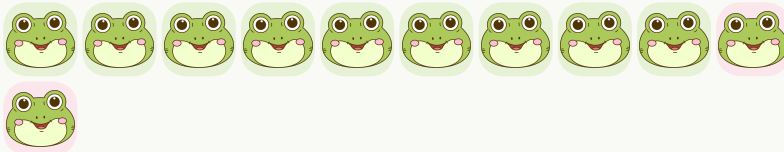
Little Math Stories

Read together. Use the pictures to help solve each story.

Grade 1

- 1 There are 9 frogs by a pond. Then 2 more frogs jump over.
How many frogs are there now?

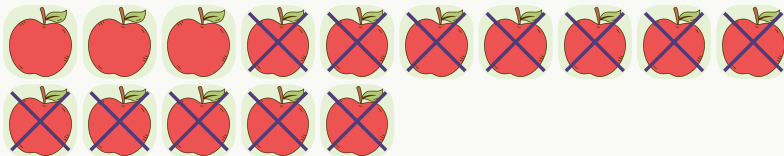
Start: 9 + Add: 2



$$\begin{array}{c} 9 + 2 \\ = \end{array}$$

- 2 There are 15 apples in a basket. Sam takes away 12 apples.
How many apples are left?

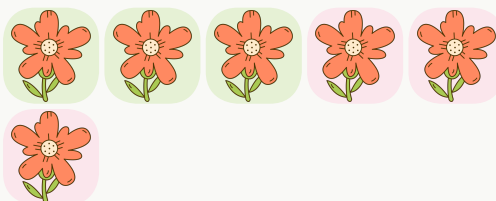
Start: 15 / Crossed out: 12



$$\begin{array}{c} 15 - 12 \\ = \end{array}$$

- 3 There are 3 flowers in a vase. Mia puts in 3 more flowers.
How many flowers are there now?

Start: 3 + Add: 3



$$\begin{array}{c} 3 + 3 \\ = \end{array}$$
