



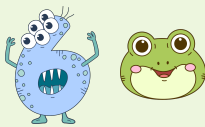

Read together. Use the pictures to help solve each story.

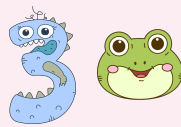
Kindergarten

START WITH



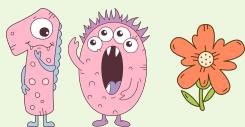

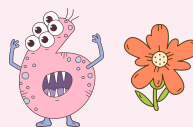
$$\begin{array}{c} \text{Blue Frog} + \text{Green Frog} \\ = \end{array}$$

START WITH



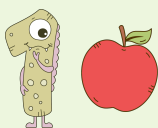
TAKE AWAY



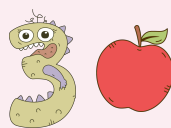
$$\begin{array}{c} \text{Pink Flower} - \text{Yellow Flower} \\ = \end{array}$$
