Read together. Use the pictures to help solve each story.

Grade 1

- 1** There are 2 frogs by a pond. Then 6 more frogs jump over.
How many frogs are there now?

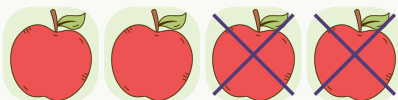
Start: 2 + Add: 6



$$\begin{array}{c} 2 + 6 \\ = \end{array}$$

- 2** There are 4 apples in a basket. Sam takes away 2 apples.
How many apples are left?

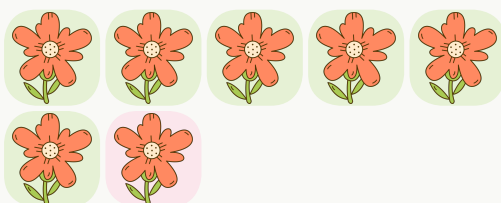
Start: 4 / Crossed out: 2



$$\begin{array}{c} 4 - 2 \\ = \end{array}$$

- 3** There are 6 flowers in a vase. Mia puts in 1 more flowers.
How many flowers are there now?

Start: 6 + Add: 1



$$\begin{array}{c} 6 + 1 \\ = \end{array}$$
