



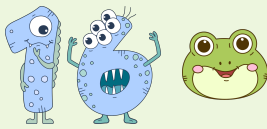

Read together. Use the pictures to help solve each story.

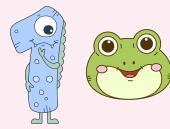
Grade 1

START WITH



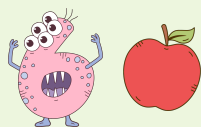

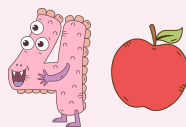
$$\begin{array}{c} 1 + 1 \\ = \end{array}$$

START WITH



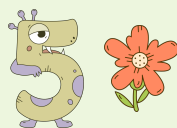
TAKE AWAY

- 3** There are 5 flowers in a vase. Mia puts in 7 more flowers.
How many flowers are there now?
